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<b>4. ABSTRACT OF THE ARTICLE:</b>	
(max 300-400 words in English)	<p>As many other examples of UE organisations working on mobility issues, the European Service (ES-BA) was constituted in 2005 as a new specialized network within the German Federal Employment Agency. It is based in 15 regional centres throughout Germany with its head office in Bonn, the Central Placement Office (ZAV). On the one side, the ES-BA network ensures extensive information, advisory services and recruitment solutions to jobseekers and employers within a European context. On the other, it also offers guidance on vocational training and further education, making it a one-stop agency that suits everyone's needs.</p> <p>In this context, the lecture makes a review of the most important experiences in the first two years of ES-BA, especially in the field of working mobility in the European Economic Area (EEA). Relevant tendencies in the European labour market as well as some common obstacles, that practitioners/counsellors should regularly find around the job placement europewide, will be here analysed.</p> <p>Finally, these experiences were processed during the Ergo-in-Net project together with similar ones of the partners and also of the counsellors in the five countries. In this sense, the lecture aims at resuming wich experiences became the background information for the Chapter 5 of the Ergo-in-Net handbook "Mobility in Europe. Guidelines for guidance practitioners".</p>
